Week 1: Garden to Plate

June 6-8, 8:30am-3pm

Does your 2nd grader help pack his lunch? Does your 4th grader use the microwave by himself? Is your 7th grader able to prepare breakfast on the stove? What's that...your child is already a Junior Chef? No worries, whether your child needs to learn basic cooking skills with and without heat or they already make delicious cuisine, Chef Pete Dorizas will be here to teach them the basics or to sharpen their skills to create master dishes.

Week 2: Easy Engineering

June 13-15, 8:30am-3pm

Is there an aspiring engineer in your family? As our younger students experience working with their first engineering kits, our older students will be designing complex structures and testing them to improve function. Field trips include going to Entertainment Junction and to GE to learn how an airplane engine is designed. (6-8 students who choose the overnight camp option will also visit the National Museum of the United States Air Force. See below for more information.)

6th – 8th graders ONLY: Sign up for the weekly camp theme, plus go to Dayton for an overnight with your friends! Mom and dad get the night off, while you stay at the Drury Inn in Dayton, go out to dinner with your friends, swim in the pool and visit the National Museum of the United States Air Force before we return to Cincinnati on Thursday. (Detailed agendas will be provided after registration.) *Please note, overnight camp should only be considered if your child is able to sleep away from home.

Week 3: STEAM Fun 101

June 20-22, 8:30am-3pm

STEAM fun and Superheroes...all in one week!

K-4: Introduce your child to the world of STEAM through the beginning stages of programming/coding and build LEGO Marvel and DC sets, all while dressing up as your favorite Marvel or DC character! And watch out...there just might be a visit from Spiderman, himself!

4-8: Let your inner designer out and explore the playful side of design and engineering while using Lego Mindstorm software and Sphero and Vortex robots.

Week 4: Everything Art

June 27-29, 8:30am-3pm

Art is a universal language in which artists can tell stories, capture history and provoke emotions. Your child will be exposed to several different mediums and forms of art, including a glassblowing demonstration at Neusole Glassworks, a fusing glass tile experience, photography, and more!

Week 5: Minecraft Mania!

July 11-13, 8:30am-3pm

Enter a world of infinite possibilities where students navigate vast landscapes and build 3D homes and objects while their characters hunt, farm and fish to survive and to simply create! Whether you are a beginner or advanced Minecrafter, you will be enthralled and challenged to think critically while creating themes and story building galore!

Week 6: Animal Planet

July 18-20, 8:30am-3pm

Back by popular demand, your child will learn unique facts about reptiles, mammals and exotic animals through hands-on experiences, such as touring Grady Veterinary Hospital and an on-campus visit from Cool Critters. Bring your courage with you...do you think you'll hold the snake?

Week 7: Invention Convention

July 25-27, 8:30am-3pm

Ready, set...create! Whether you like to take things apart and figure out how they work or you like to invent things that serve no real purpose or that will make you rich, this week of camp is for you! Come be challenged to test your creativity and visit a true Maker Space. For once you'll have fun tearing things apart without getting in trouble from mom and dad!

LGS students entering Kindergarten-8 or who have just graduated from grade 8 are eligible.

Siblings of LGS students who are entering grades 1 – 8 may also enroll for a largely discounted rate to encourage reverse inclusion.

Please see separate registration form for siblings. Limited slots are available - no more than three siblings per week!

Daily activities: language arts, social skills and art.

Weekly activities: bowling or field trips to the park, one theme related in-house or off campus field trip, library field trip, and swim at the Blue Ash Y.

Deposit (due 4/14/17): A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration for each week of camp in which you enroll your child. Your camp deposit amount, however, will never exceed a total of \$300. Camp deposits will be applied to your total tuition costs.

Tuition:

First tuition payment (**due 5/19/17**): If your child is attending three or less weeks of camp, your remaining balance is due at this time. If your child is attending 4+ weeks of camp, half of your remaining balance is due at this time.

Second tuition payment (**due 6/22/17**): If your child is attending 4+ camps, your remaining balance is due at this time.

If you request a week change after April 14th, we will do our best to accommodate your request. If this is not possible due to high enrollment, you may choose to keep the slot for your original week or to give up your slot for your original week, thereby forfeiting your deposit for that week.
