### **Eligibility:**

- All LGS students entering grades on the **4-6 or 6-8 teams for the 18-19 year or graduating from grade 8.**
- A select number of non-LGS students entering grades 4-8 for the 18-19 year (students must meet typical school-year LGS admission requirements).
- "Typical" siblings of current LGS students entering grades 4-8 for reverse-inclusion purposes. \*No more than 3 siblings per week.
- See Program B for students entering grades on the K-2 or 2-4 teams for the 18-19 year.

**Payment Information:**

**Deposit (due 4/16/18):** A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration for each week of camp in which you enroll your child. Your camp deposit amount, however, will never exceed a total of \$300. Camp deposits will be applied to your total tuition costs.

**Tuition:**

First tuition payment (**due 5/18/18**): If your child is attending three or less weeks of camp, your remaining balance is due at this time. If your child is attending 4+ weeks of camp, half of your remaining balance is due at this time.

Second tuition payment (**due 6/21/18**): If your child is attending 4+ camps, your remaining balance is due at this time.

If you request a week change after April 16<sup>th</sup>, we will do our best to accommodate your request. If this is not possible due to high enrollment, you may choose to keep the slot for your original week or to give up your slot for your original week, thereby forfeiting your deposit for that week.
