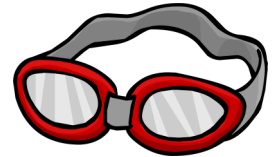
(Minimum of students needed: 10 Maximum allowable: 20)

Tuesday — Taekwondo at LGS

Ahn Taekwondo Institute is known for its quality martial arts instruction with a flare for FUN. Students will learn basic motions, forms and techniques while working on coordination, flexibility, listening, cooperation, and more. At the end of each term, students may also have the opportunity to test and rank up to the next color belt.

Session dates: Tuesdays, Nov 27— Feb 19, 3:10-4:00

Wednesday — Lego Club at LGS (grades 3-8)

Students will free build, pattern build, and build new LEGO® projects each week. LGS staff facilitate projects while providing students a safe place to explore and create. Each session provides an opportunity for kids to develop their creativity and imagination. (Minimum of students needed: 5 Maximum allowable: 12)

Please Note — LEGO® materials used to build the models are reused from week to week.

Students will not take home the completed models as that would make the cost of the class excessively high.



Thursday — Calm Resilient Kids (grades 2-8)

Calm Resilient Kids offers training in calming and self-regulation for students with autism. Techniques include: mindful movements, breath awareness, guided meditation/imagery, music, reflection, working with color, and more. Sessions are led by Sherry McHenry, a stress management consultant and certified Connected Kids trainer.
