Dear LGS Families,

On Friday, May 22nd, we have an awesome opportunity being made available to all students from the Siekman family (Tazz and Max's parents). Our school has been invited to their farm for the day! There will be plenty of fun activities available, such as fishing, paddle boats, creeking, tractor/Gator rides, horse care (students can feed/pet/brush), goats (feed from fence), chicken, rabbit, and guinea pig interactions, a seed station for planting, bubbles, a corn hole tournament and more! (Each activity is optional...students can pick the ones that most interest them.)

We will use this day as our May pizza day and will be ordering the pizza from La Rosa's for lunch. Drinks, applesauce, and cookies will also be provided for lunch, and bottled water, string cheese, push up yogurts, and gluten-free pretzels/regular pretzels will also be available to snack on during the day. If your child does NOT eat pizza and/or care for the snack items, please send their lunch/snack in a clearly marked bag.

Please apply sunscreen to your child, prior to their arrival at school. We will continue to reapply sunscreen during the day. If your child burns easily, it would be helpful to email your team ahead of time so they can reapply sunscreen more frequently. The school will have sunscreen handy; however, if your child requires a specific brand, you will need to send it in a sealed baggie with your child's name clearly marked on the bag.

We will be transporting students to the farm via bus; however, parents will also have the option of dropping off/picking up at the farm if the farm is more in a more convenient location. Please note, that regardless of your child's typical schedule at LG, the bus will departing LG at 9:15am and we are unable to "hold" the bus for late arrivals. As well, the bus is departing the Siekman farm at 2pm, and we are unable to "hold" the bus for parents who are late picking their child up at the farm. (Pick up time at the farm is 1:45pm.) There will be a nominal charge of \$5/student to cover the cost of transportation and incidentals.
